My wife has endured a dental issue, which resulted in 5 total appointments, including a root canal, and a porcelain crown. Please pray for healing and that she has no further issues with this tooth. While it was not a fun experience, (well, no dental appointment is ever fun!) we thank the Lord for allowing us to have these modern essentials that we know others do not have access too.

We love getting things from the states! We are excited for every card, letter, care package, gift etc., but especially when it is family coming to visit. We have been blessed the last several weeks by a visit from Jamie's mother and her sister and family. We have been able to show them the sights of Bangkok and our ministry here in Thailand. It was not difficult for them to see the need almost immediately upon arriving. It's indescribable how Bangkok can have several state of the art malls, Lamborghini's passing by, but very few Christians or churches.

Being a foreigner, there is never a time when we are out in the city when people don't ask us what we are doing here. On one of our errands a young man asked us that same question. After we told him, he began to explain how he was a Christian and how he got saved. We each rejoiced to know a fellow believer. Unless we are at church we don't see or hear about Christians, but the ones we do hear from are excited about such a wonderful Saviour.
