We made the trip to Singapore to secure our Visas. After living in Bangkok for almost 11 months it was a great surprise to be able to speak English to nearly everyone we met. Not to mention we met several Christians while being there. Everything went smoothly and without any trouble. We want to thank you for your prayers and support. We are aware it was a timely process to attain our visa's. However, several have said that it normally takes well over a year for the missionary visa to be approved and completed. We began the process in May and had the Visa in hand in December. So, we hope you share in the joy with us as The Lord has blessed us in this matter.

One evening while riding in a taxi the driver wanted to know what we were doing in Singapore. I explained to him we were missionaries and we were are obtaining our missionary Visas he said, "Praise the Lord, good to meet you brother." Upon arriving in Bangkok the taxi driver asked why we traveled to Singapore and I explained to him about our missionary Visas. He said, "Buddhists, Muslims, and Christians are all the same." It reminded me as soon as I arrived back in Thailand the great need for Christ, and why my family was here.

Christmas is a time of grand celebration in Thailand. There are Christmas trees in every mall and Christmas music playing all day long. Most have never heard the true story of the birth of Christ. We were thankful to get many opportunities, to share the gospel and all the miracles of the Bible.

Christmas is also a great time of outreach here in Thailand just as it is in the states. We planned a Christmas party for all of Jamie's English students and my Professionals Sunday School Class. Most had never had turkey and asked us to prepare a traditional Christmas dinner. We had food and Christmas games and even a gift exchange with Christians and non-Christians intermingling. The Bible study definitely caused many of the lost to have many questions about salvation. Please pray as the gospel is presented every week to the English students, that they would be receptive in 2015.
